# Wodonga Catholic Parish Including Bethanga, Dederang, Mt Beauty and Tangambalanga Communities July 29th -2018 - The 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ YEAR B ~



Words of Our Pope: Let us not forget that Jesus asked his disciples to pay attention to details. The little detail that wine was running out at a party. The little detail that one sheep was missing. The little detail of noticing the widow who offered her two small coins. The little detail of having spare oil for the lamps,

should the bridegroom delay. The little detail of asking the disciples how many loaves of bread they had. Pope Francis, Gaudete Et Exsultate (2018) para 144.

Looking at the Readings: The miraculous multiplications of bread appear in both the first reading (2 Kings 4:42-44) and in the Gospel (John 6:1-15). Are such miracles common? When people are hungry, bread is provided: for Elisha's men (today's reading), for David's army (1 Sam 21:2-7), Elijah and the widow (1 Kings 17:13-16) and bread and water (Kings 19:5-8) and the manna in the desert (Exodus 16:12-15, next Sunday's first reading). The multiplication of loaves are mention seven times in the gospels: Matt 14:19; Matt 15:36; Matt 16:9,10; Mark 6:41; Mark 8:19,20; Luke 9:16 and John 6:11 (today's Gospel). There is something about bread! Barley loaves, the product of the first fruits of the harvest are offered in thanksgiving; bread is an instrument of human community and expresses the nobility of human work. Bread is used to symbolise unity and giving strength (Psalm 104); wisdom and understanding (Proverbs 9:5), offering for forgiveness (Numbers 5:15); and worship (Ezekiel 46:14) and blessing (Genesis 14:18-20) and in John's Gospel peace and life, God's word and Christ's body. For five weeks we read from John chapter 6, Christ's teaching about the implication of the miracle, about the Fucharist and about eternal life.

### GOSPEL: JOHN 6:1-15



lesus went off to the other side of the Sea of Galilee - or of Tiberias - and a large crowd followed him, impressed by the signs he gave by curing the sick. Jesus climbed the hillside, and sat down there with his disciples. It was shortly before the Jewish feast of Passover. Looking up, Jesus saw the crowds approaching and said to Philip, 'Where can we buy some bread for these people to eat?' He only said this to test Philip; he himself knew exactly what he was going to do. Philip answered, 'Two hundred denarii would only buy enough to give them a small piece each.' One of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, said, 'There is a small boy here with five barley loaves and two fish; but what is that between so many?' Jesus said to them, 'Make the people sit down.' There was plenty of grass there, and as many as five thousand men sat down. Then Jesus took the loaves, gave thanks and gave them out to all who were sitting ready; he then did the same with the fish, giving out as much as was wanted. When they had eaten enough he said to the disciples, 'Pick up the pieces left over, so that nothing gets wasted.' So they picked them up, and filled twelve hampers with scraps left over from the meal of five barley loaves. The people, seeing this sign that he had given, said, 'This really is the prophet who is to come into the world.' Jesus, who could see they were about to come and take him by force and make him king, escaped back to the hills by himself.


