Looking at the Readings:

How do we know we are on the right path to eternal life? We find that there are many paths in life and various ways to live our Christian faith. Christian writers and spiritual directors would attest that there are many paths. The readings today have an intersecting line that crosses all the paths and provide us with a verifying and connecting rule: fraternal charity. Barnabas vouches for Paul. Barnabas described Paul's conversion and actions, but it was not just his words but also his charity and faith that convinced the disciples Acts 4:36, 11:4.

The second reading, John's first letter, emphasises that following Christ, believing in his word, obeying his commandments comes from God's love for us and our love for one another (3:23).

Finally the gospel image of the vine stressed the need to be connected, abiding with Christ and bearing fruit. It is in bearing fruit that we are known as his disciples (15:8). Fruit is the producing, the action of our charity to one another.

Gospel: John 15:1-8

Jesus said to his disciples:

'I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinedresser. Every branch in me that bears no fruit he cuts away, and every branch that does bear fruit he prunes to make it bear even more. You are pruned already, by means of the word that I have spoken to you. Make your home in me, as I make mine in you. As a branch cannot bear fruit all by itself, but must remain part of the vine, neither can you unless you remain in me. I am the vine, you are the branches.
Whoever remains in me, with me in him, bears fruit in plenty; for cut off from me you can do nothing. Anyone who does not remain in me is like a branch that has been thrown away - he withers; these branches are collected and thrown on the fire, and they are burnt. If you remain in me and my words remain in you, you may ask what you will and you shall get it.

It is to the glory of my Father that you should bear much fruit, and then you will be my disciples.'
