Looking at the Readings

Jesus' response to Pilate's questioning: is: "My Kingdom does not belong to this world" is attested in many ways. Firstly by his next sentence: "His men would not go into battle to rescue him" Violence or coercion has never been his way of teaching. Nor did he practice insidious ways by exploiting people's hopes and dreams of an earthy paradise and power over others. Again he did not sugar-coat his message: there will be times of want and difficulty, his disciples may not be welcomed, there would be persecution and even death. He had to rebuke his apostles who vied for power and position, revenge and superiority.

Jesus' reign is to bear witness to the truth, to proclaim the beatitudes as a way of being and life and bringing healing, peace and forgiveness; to be a shepherd and a servant to all, to welcome children, the poor and the sinner. Herod's and Pilate's curiosity was mixed with fear and an inability to understand Jesus' mission and life. Jesus' disciples fear and confusion were overcome by faith and understanding and acceptance of love and forgiveness. This feast day, the readings give us vision of the future and reassurance in the gift of Christ as universal Saviour.

The Lorica (the Deer's Cry) St Patrick

The Icon of Christ the King reminds us of mystery of Christ's passion death, resurrection and ascension into the glory of heaven. The Deer's Cry hymn reminds us both of the trials of life and the comfort of Christ.

I arise today through the strength of heaven ...

Through God's strength to pilot me.

God's eye to look before me, God's wisdom to guide me,

God's way to lie before me, God's shield to protect me ...

Christ with me, Christ before me,

Christ behind me, Christ in me,

Christ beneath me, Christ above me,

Christ when I arise, Christ to shield me,

Christ in the heart of everyone who thinks of me,

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Re: Confirmation Weekend & Alternative Masses at St Augustine's

Come 27/28 November and 4/5 December 2021, as a parish we celebrate our Confirmation weekends here in Wodonga. We have 109 children to be confirmed from 90 families. Let us pray for them as they celebrate and receive the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist over those two weekends.

That being said we need to work with the current regulations regarding gatherings and density limits.

This means for the Masses here at Sacred Heart on the Saturday/Sunday 27/28 November and on the Saturday/ Sunday 4/5 December, we need to give preference to the Candidates of Confirmation and their families.

Masses will be celebrated for the regular parishioners at St Augustine's Church (55 High St Wodonga).

Still prior booking is preferred.

Masses will still be: 5:00 pm Saturday, 8:30 & 10:30 am Sunday, on both of those weekends.

In all these Masses, we need to establish that you are fully-vaccinated.

For the Sacramental candidates and families, please ensure that all your guests aged 16 and older have full-vaccination status and have the evidence ready when checking in at the Church.
