# Looking at the Readings:

There is another sense of urgency in the readings today, comparable to last week's urgency in the second coming of Christ to the urgency and immediacy on the Coming of Christ for each generation and for all peoples: god fearing and the pagans. The responsorial psalm acknowledges that both the Israelites and the heathens will marvel at the great works of God in bringing peace and freedom. Baruch, one time secretary to Jeremiah and a prophet in his own right urges the people to celebrate this freedom and peace in the coming of the Lord.

We are to take this marvellous work of God personally. While this is for all nations, it is also for each individual. The Call of John the Baptist in the Gospel is one of repentance and conversion. Each heart and soul is to hear the voice and personally turn to God.

St Pauls letter to the Philippians (second reading) iterates the message for every generation, then, now and for the future. The message is one of joy, love and goodness.

# The Second Sunday of Advent:



The second candle, also purple, represents faith. It is called the "Bethlehem Candle" as a reminder of Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem.

Advent means "coming" in Latin. In Greek, it is translated from parousia, commonly used in reference to the Second Coming of the Messiah. It is a season of preparation, to prepare the way of the Lord. Scripture readings during Advent reflect themes of hope of eternal life as well as accountability for our faithfulness.

Looking back to the past and the birth of Christ as well as the future of Christ's coming again, Advent can be a season of spiritual journey for individuals as well as congregations as we wait in a spirit of expectation, anticipation, preparation and longing.

Each year we await the rebirth of Christ when the world will be reconciled with God. The Anointed One, a Messiah, will bring peace, justice, and righteousness to the world.

# Gospel: Luke 3:1-6

In the fifteenth year of Tiberius Caesar's reign, when Pontius Pilate was governor of Judaea, Herod tetrarch of Galilee, his brother Philip tetrarch of the lands of Ituraea and Trachonitis, Lysanias tetrarch of Abilene, during the pontificate of Annas and Caiaphas, the word of God came to John son of Zechariah, in the wilderness. He went through the whole Jordan district proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins, as it is written in the book of the sayings of the prophet Isaiah:

> A voice cries in the wilderness: Prepare a way for the Lord, make his paths straight. Every valley will be filled in, every mountain and hill be laid low, winding ways will be straightened and rough roads made smooth.

And all mankind shall see the salvation of God.
