#### Looking at the Readings:

At first glance, it appears that there is a certain ruthlessness about the image of the vinedresser pruning the vine: perform or perish! However, the process of cutting away and pruning branches is an incredibly nurturing action; it is removing the unproductive portions of the plant so that the vine has an even better opportunity to produce fruit in the next season. It is an act of love; not an act of economic rationalism. Within our own lives we are called to make decisions about which of our thoughts and actions are life-giving (fruit-bearing) and which are unproductive; negative; crippling; life-diminishing. If we are able to 'prune' our life-diminishing thoughts and actions we allow ourselves the freedom and the ability to really flourish. Feelings of jealousy, greed, resentment, self-doubt and lack of confidence can limit our ability to be fully alive just as addictive and harmful behaviours can physically take away our ability to perform at our best. It is only through a process of cutting away and pruning that we can nurture ourselves to realise the beauty of our potential. © Greg Sunter

#### **Liturgical Jottings: Altar Wine**



When at the request of his Mother Mary, Jesus turned water into wine at the wedding at Cana, it was the best of all wines. At the Last Supper, Jesus "took a cup ... saying, 'Drink from it, all of you, for this is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed on behalf of many for the forgiveness of sins'" (Matthew 26:27-28). The wine had to be pure and true wine. Our Lord also said, "For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink" (John 6:55). Altar wines have to meet requirements set by canon law and the General Instructions of the Roman Missal (GIRM). Briefly, Canon 924§3 declares: "The wine must be natural, made from grapes of the vine, and not corrupt." GIRM 322 continues: "The wine for the celebration

of the Eucharist must be made from the fruit of the vine (Luke 22:18), natural and unadulterated, that is, without admixture of extraneous substances."

#### Gospel John 15:1-8

Jesus said to his disciples:

'I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinedresser.

Every branch in me that bears no fruit he cuts away,

and every branch that does bear fruit he prunes to make it bear even more.

You are pruned already, by means of the word that I have spoken to you.

Make your home in me, as I make mine in you. As a branch cannot bear fruit all by itself, but must remain part of the vine, neither can you unless you remain in me.

I am the vine, you are the branches.

Whoever remains in me, with me in him,

bears fruit in plenty; for cut off from me you can do nothing.

Anyone who does not remain in me is like a branch that has been thrown away - he withers;

#### Part-time Unit of Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) in Bendigo 2024

A part-time Unit of CPE will be conducted in Bendigo in the second semester of 2024, from Wed.10th July to Thurs. 28th Nov. The course will be conducted by the North-east Victoria CPE Centre.

Supervised by Anne Wieczorek, a Spiritual Care Practitioner at Bendigo Health, who is an accredited Provisional Clinical Pastoral Educator, and Louise Ross, a Pastoral Carer at Wharparilla Lodge Echuca Community for the Aged, and a Provisional Clinical Pastoral Supervisor. It will be conducted in meeting rooms at Bendigo Baptist Church, 757 McIvor Hwy, Junortoun. The program will be conducted on Wednesdays from 9:00 am – 4.00 pm, with attendance on 3 Thursdays also required (11th July 26th September, and 28th November).

A further one and a half days each week is required for the delivery of spiritual/pastoral care in an approved placement and further time is also needed for writing reports on

spiritual/pastoral encounters, so participants need to be able to devote at least 3 days each week for the 21 weeks of the program. Prospective applicants should contact the Course Coordinator, Anne Wieczorek,
