Acknowledgement of Country

We, Wodonga Catholic Parish, acknowledge the Traditional Custodians of the land where our churches, schools and buildings are located. We pay our respect to the Aboriginal people and Elders past and present whose spirits dwell in this land. May the spirit of this ancient land be always with us.

From our Pope: The Mother of Jesus is the living invocation of the Holy Spirit. She is the Mother of the Church. We entrust to her all communities that at this moment are most in need of the Spirit, who is the Defender and Comforter, the Spirit of truth, freedom, and peace.



Focus on the Readings:

The reading from the Book of Deuteronomy is a reflection or meditation on the presence and power of God from creation to the time of the Exodus. He is God in heaven and God on Earth. The people began to experience the nearness of God. They became familiar with his ways. He was their protection and their provider. As we listen to this reading at Mass or later we gain a sense of the work, life and love of the Trinity.

The second reading builds on this foundational experience of God. We are children of God (RNJB translation) able to call God, "Abba, Father" as Jesus taught.

The Gospel of Matthew's is the account of the commissioning of the Apostles and Jesus' ascension. The Trinity is explicitly named as Father, Son and Holy Spirit – not as a theological formula but as the direction of the Apostles' preaching and celebration of sacraments. Children learn the sign of the cross and the name of the Trinity well before they come to understand. May our experiences and meditation of the mystery of God lead us to deeper living out of our love and commitment to God and neighbour.

Quote for the Day:

The Church announces the good tidings of salvation to those who do not believe, so that all may know the true God and Jesus Christ whom He has sent, and may be converted from their ways, doing penance. To believers also the Church must ever preach faith and penance, she must prepare them for the sacraments, teach them to observe all that Christ has commanded and invite them to all the works of charity, piety, and the apostolate. For all these works make it clear that Christ's faithful, though not of this world, are to be the light of the world and to glorify the Father before men and women. (*Constitution on the Liturgy art.* 9)
