Pope Francis:

The reality of Christ's flesh and his blood leaves no room for doubt both according to the Lord's teaching and our faith. We are speaking of true flesh and true blood when we receive and absorb these substances, they put us in Christ and Christ in us. Is this not the truth? What we are is in God. (St Hilary of Poitiers).

Strengthened by this food from heaven we shall make the most of our opportunities and whatever the difficulties of our journey, and walking at a brisk pace we shall arrive at this promised day of eternal life.
